A- KWI LOOKOUT #319693-749 Grey Road 1 - Come for the views! Stay for the "tea party", the history and a monarch waystation. Chat with monarch butterfly expert Audrey Armstrong. Small parking lot.

B- FRITZ & MORRISON- #177 Sutacriti Street - Overlooking Georgian Bay, a large picturesque garden features rockfalls, spring-fed ponds, bridges & fountains. Among the shade sanctuaries is "The Chapel", featuring a stained-glass window from Kemble-Sarawak Church. At the waterfront, check the view to Cobble Beach or sit at the wisteria-covered pergola. **NOTE: RAFFLE DRAW** tickets will be sold here for: metal art designed by Rob Thomas; items donated from Owen Sound Home Depot; and items from Pynns' farm. Proceeds to Hospice.

C- SERENDIPITY FLORAL FARM - #424073 Taylor Sideroad - Beautiful, locally grown flowers for all occasions, grown in the picturesque one-acre garden of an 1880 farmhouse; farm located on the Niagara Escarpment at the base of Kemble Mountain. Parking next to house.

D- ROOTED BY THE BLUFFS #170513 Centre Road - An ecological plant nursery alongside permaculture gardens showcase medicinal, edible, and native perennials. Mixed fruit and nut orchard in development. Conducted tours only - numbers limited, based on health guidelines – run every hour from 11:30 to 3:30 pm. Parking in field.

E- WHITES #503161 Grey Road 1- A lush, charming, and compact garden with small waterfall and pond.

F- KEPPEL CROFT #504156 Grey Road 1 - Stretches over 4 acres to include perennial borders, henge, Zen, trails, and rockery. One of Canada's top gardens! Parking lot. Charming **PRIVY**.

G- PYNNS' FARM #504240 Grey Road 1 - Blueberries, haskaps, hardy kiwis, goji berries, elderberries and saskatoons. In back, a large beaver pond; at front, a beautiful, elevated view of Georgian Bay and Griffith, Hay and White Cloud Islands. A steep entrance leads to a one-way roundabout and parking at house and orchard.

H- CENTENNIAL PARK #504623 Grey Road 1 - A public garden overtaken by volunteers! Although the lilac bridal path is past, the top berm garden is primed for late summer. **PRIVY** and parking in the park at bottom of steep entrance hill.

J- WILSONS #504877 Grey Road 1 - From fire to fantasy, a garden 20 years in the making and still ongoing. Monarch butterfly waystation. 6 parking spaces at top of drive.
